## VM MOTOR GAINS FINAL WIN AT WSK

A good debut for VM Motor at Sarno, where Adam Janous manages to test engines and chassis in all sorts of weather conditions forecasted for the World Championship round in September that will be held on this very track: "I managed to qualify for prefinal only thanks to repechage because I got mixed up with the pack during qualifiers when it was raining and, although I was 12th I got pushed back. Then in qualifying heats, I had one or two problems with fine tuning my engine," the Czech driver said disappointedly. The bad weather conditions and just Janous on the track, without any comrade capable of testing different tuning or approve of what he had done conditioned the final results of the meeting in Sarno: **There are more of us at the next meeting, so it will be easier, even if is highly improbable that we'll find the same conditions as those we have had here.** From grid 22 in final, the Czech team can only do better, and return to Sarno in September to play all its cards.
